

Mr. Hamlet is an operating partner with Green Hospitality Partners, an investment vehicle for the acquisition of hotels and a management company. He also currently serves as a senior consultant to Uprise Energy, the world's first portable 10kW wind turbine; a board member and senior advisor to VenueBook, an online event platform that facilitates booking of functions in restaurants, hotels and large-format venues located in major U.S. metropolitan areas; a board member of and senior advisor to Loyyal, a blockchain-based loyalty program

Mr. Hamlet has a wide spectrum of executive experience, notably his tenure from 1983 to 1991 as president and CEO of Holiday Inns Inc. Hotel Group, then the largest hospitality concern in the world. During his tenure, Mr. Hamlet was instrumental in introducing two new brands (Hampton Inn and Embassy Suites) and played a significant role in the integration of Harrah's into Holiday Corp. He also participated in the

\$2.5 billion recapitalization of the company in 1987. Under his stewardship, Holiday Corporation grew the following brands: Hampton Inns, Embassy Suites, Residence Inn as well as the company's namesake, Holiday Inns, which was Mr. Hamlet's primary focus with over 3,600 hotels worldwide including more than 3,000 franchisees

In 1992, after the sale of Holiday Inns, Inc., Mr. Hamlet founded and became chairman and CEO of Hamlet Holdings LLC. In 1998, Mr. Hamlet acquired, with Knowledge Universe as his partner, The Executive Committee (TEC) (now Vistage), and became its Chairman and Chief Executive Officer. Vistage International and its global affiliates have more than 13,000 members in 15 countries, representing the world's largest CEO membership organization based on revenue

Since 2004, Mr. Hamlet has served as operating partner at AEA Investors, Executive Chairman of Digital Kitchen LLC, Chairman of Resource Nation, Senior Advisor to Crestview Partners and as an advisor to numerous businesses including Neuehouse, TouchCommerce, LogicSource and Noble Iron
